

EI 3v3 Tournament Rules

Please note: subject to change!!

Format:

- Round robin
- Score system: sum of total points from round robin play.
- Ties- two way- head to head winner advances.
 - Three way – team with most points against drops out, then head to head.
 - Four way – team with most points against drops out, team with 2nd most points scored against drops out, then head to head.
- Round play games are to 15 (games can be won 15-14).
- Quarter finals are to 21 (win by 2).
- Final game is best out of 3 games to 15 points (win by 2).
- Switch sides of the court when the first team reaches 8 points for games to 15 or 11 points for games to 21.

In-game rules:

- On disputed calls, captains discuss and figure it out.
- Call tighter on Challenge Level (Rec level is easier on sets, etc.).
- Girls can set serves and set over; guys cannot.
- NO one-handed sets or open-hand dinks!
- Block does not count as part of 3 hits.
- NO touching net at any time during play, unless ball moves the net into you.
- Line moves, it is in!
- One time-out only with possession.
- Hard-driven balls can be doubled.
- Cannot go onto other court.
- Cannot have a foot, hand, or more go fully under the net.
- Wire shots – Any attack that is between the two poles is legal.
- No attacking the serve.
- In the Recreational Division you are required to serve underhand.

*A team needs to start with 3 players. Only if one player is injured during the tournament can a team play with 2.

If a team forfeits or is a no-show, the score is recorded 15-0.
