II. DEAD IN SIN - THE COMMON STARTING POINT FOR ALL BELIEVERS

- A. Common Conditions Dead to God
 - 1. *Dead* in our trespasses and sins
 - a. Not trapped
 - b. Not imprisoned
 - c. Not bound
 - 2. Dead in our trespasses and sins
 - a. The fault for our condition lies completely in our actions
- B. **Common Path** What Does Life Look Like When We are Dead?
 - 1. According to the course of the world
 - a. According to the culture in which we found ourselves
 - b. Applies to both the nation and the time in which we grew up

- 2. According to the prince of the power of the air
 - a. Devil is behind it all
 - b. The common factor in all cultures is that they produce a spirit of disobedience to God
- 3. According to our personal lusts
 - a. Desires of the flesh Body oriented desires
 - b. Desires of the mind Intellectually oriented desires
