II. THE BATTLE IS IN THE MIND AND THE ISSUE IS FAITH

A. Two key conflicts

- 1. Eve Genesis 3
 - a. Two sets of thoughts
 - (1) God's word and goodness
 - (2) Devil's word and doubts about God
 - b. Eve will act on one of those thoughts
 - (1) The thoughts on which she acts is her faith
- 2. The Lord in the wilderness Matthew 4:1-11
 - a. The Father had made His plan clear
 - b. The devil made appeals step aside from the plan
 - c. Jesus stood with His Father acted by faith

 - a. War to destroy thoughts exalted against God
 - b. Thoughts brought captive to Christ
- 2. James 4:6-7
 - a. Submit to God Resist the devil

 - a. Devil goes about like a roaring lion
 - b. Whom resist firm in faith

C. Key alternatives to faith

- 1. Pride trust yourselves
- 2. Fear do not trust anyone

D. In Ephesians the second seems to be the emphasis

- 1. Because of the call to be strong
- 2. Because of the call to fight
- 3. Because of the appeal of Paul for prayer
