I. FOR THIS REASON

- A. Because Jesus is the heir of all things.
- B. Because Jesus is seated in the place of authority.
- C. Note the similarity to the transfiguration.

II. WE MUST PAY MUCH CLOSER ATTENTION.

- A. Possibly "closer" More attention than to the Old Testament
- B. Possibly "closest" Because other things pull at our attention
 - 1. Parable of the sower

HEBREWS 2:1-3

1 "FOR THIS REASON WE MUST PAY MUCH CLOSER ATTENTION TO WHAT WE HAVE HEARD, SO THAT WE DO NOT DRIFT AWAY FROM IT. FOR IF THE WORD SPOKEN THROUGH ANGELS PROVED UNALTERABLE, AND EVERY TRANSGRESSION AND DISOBEDIENCE RECEIVED A JUST PENALTY, HOW WILL WE ESCAPE IF WE NEGLECT SO GREAT A SALVATION? AFTER IT WAS AT THE FIRST SPOKEN THROUGH THE LORD, IT WAS CONFIRMED TO US BY THOSE WHO HEARD."

MARK 9:5-8

5 "Peter said to Jesus, 'Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three tabernacles, one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah.' 6 For he did not know what to answer; for they became terrified. 7 Then a cloud formed, overshadowing them, and a voice came out of the cloud, 'This is My Son, listen to Him!' 8 All at once they looked around and saw no one with them anymore, except Jesus alone."
