I. REVIEW - HEBREWS 3:6

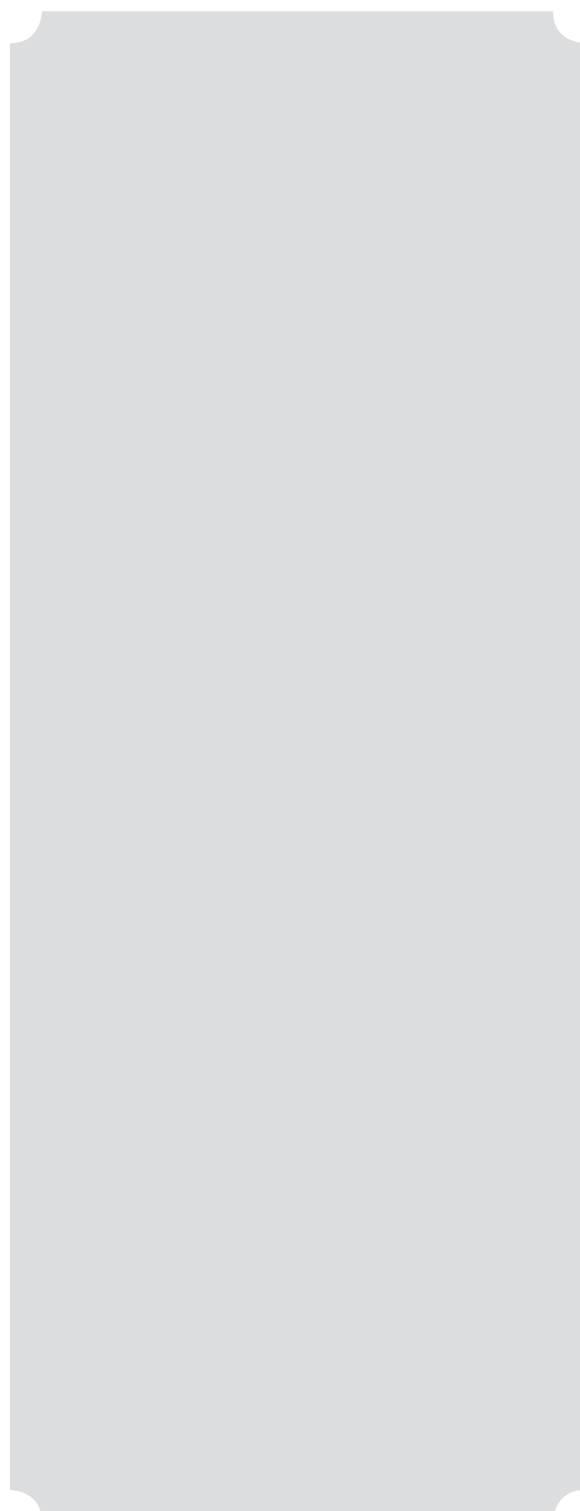
- A. Whose house we are

**III. COMPLAINT ABOUT WATER FROM
EXODUS 17:1-7**

- A. The Exodus from Egypt pictures the salvation in Jesus Christ.
 - 1. Moses is a type of Christ.
 - 2. The Exodus is a type of our deliverance.
 - 3. The wilderness experience is a warning.



B. Key features of the story

1. The people complained because of a water shortage.
2. The complaining group had seen a great deal of the power and love of God.
3. The people chose to respond in self-concern rather than in faith. “Is the Lord among us or not?”

C. Lessons on unbelief

1. Unbelief can occur while God is showering blessing.
2. Unbelief is not the inability to believe but the refusal to believe.
3. Unbelief here is not “fall away” but willfully moving away.
4. Unbelief always will finally express itself as disobedience.
