I. WHAT ARE WE SURE ABOUT IN THIS PASSAGE?

- A. The section runs from Hebrews 5:11-6:12.
 - 1. The whole section divides into two distinct parts.
 - a. You-We (vs. 5:11-6:3; 6:9-12)
 - b. In the case of those (vs. 6:4-8)
- B. The condition of the people addressed as "you"
 - 1. Dull of hearing (vs. 5:11)
 - 2. Immature (vs. 5:13)
 - 3. Sluggish (vs. 6:12)
- C. Reason for the condition: No action of faith on the truth received
- D. The goal of the warning
 - 1. Let us press on to maturity (vs. 6:1)
 - 2. That they might experience the full assurance of hope (vs. 6:11)

3. Through faith and patience, inherit the promise. (vs. 6:12)

III. How should we understand the "those" section?

A. Key points in the interpretation

- 1. The warning must reflect a real danger to the Hebrews.
- 2. The blessings "those" received must be understood.
- 3. The danger is to come to a place where repentance, and therefore salvation, are "impossible."
- 4. The writer says that this experience does not "accompany" salvation.
- 5. Our interpretation must agree with the rest of the teaching of Scripture.
