### I. WITHOUT THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD THERE IS NO FORGIVENESS

A. The basis of fellowship with God is always a sacrifice.

- 1. In the Old Covenant, multiple sacrifices
  - a) Never got men to God
  - b) In their repetition, it became a reminder of sin.
- 2. In the New Covenant, a sacrifice is provided which finishes the work.
  - a) Brings us to God
  - b) Cleanses our consciences from guilt

## II. By One Sacrifice He Has Perfected For All Time

- A. Hebrews 9:12
  - 1. By His own blood
  - 2. Eternal redemption
- B. Hebrews 9:26
  - 1. The sacrifice of Jesus Christ to put away sin is the consummation of the ages.

#### HEBREWS 9:12

"AND NOT THROUGH THE BLOOD OF GOATS AND CALVES, BUT THROUGH HIS OWN BLOOD, HE ENTERED THE HOLY PLACE ONCE FOR ALL, HAVING OBTAINED ETERNAL REDEMPTION."

#### HEBREWS 9:26

"Otherwise, He would have needed to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now once at the consummation of the ages He has been manifested to put away sinby the sacrifice of Himself."

1. The once-for-all sacrifice was the purpose of His first coming.

#### D. Hebrews 10:10

1. The sacrifice of Jesus Christ answers all the deficient Old Testament sacrifices.

#### E. Hebrews 10:12

1. The prediction that He would sit down at the right hand of God is the proof that the sacrifice was sufficient.

#### F. Hebrews 10:14

1. The result of the once-for-all is that we have been permanently cleansed.

# III. APPLICATION - WE MUST NEVER ALLOW ANYTHING TO BE PLACED ALONGSIDE THAT SACRIFICE AS A HOPE OF ACCESS TO GOD.

#### HEBREWS 9:28

"SO CHRIST ALSO, HAVING BEEN OF-FERED ONCE TO BEAR THE SINS OF MANY, WILL APPEAR A SECOND TIME FOR SALVATION WITHOUT REFERENCE TO SIN, TO THOSE WHO EAGERLY AWAIT HIM."

#### **Hebrews 10:10**

"By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

#### **HEBREWS 10:12**

"But He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God."

#### **HEBREWS 10:14**

"For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified."
