A. The impact of faith on life. (Heb 11:1-2)

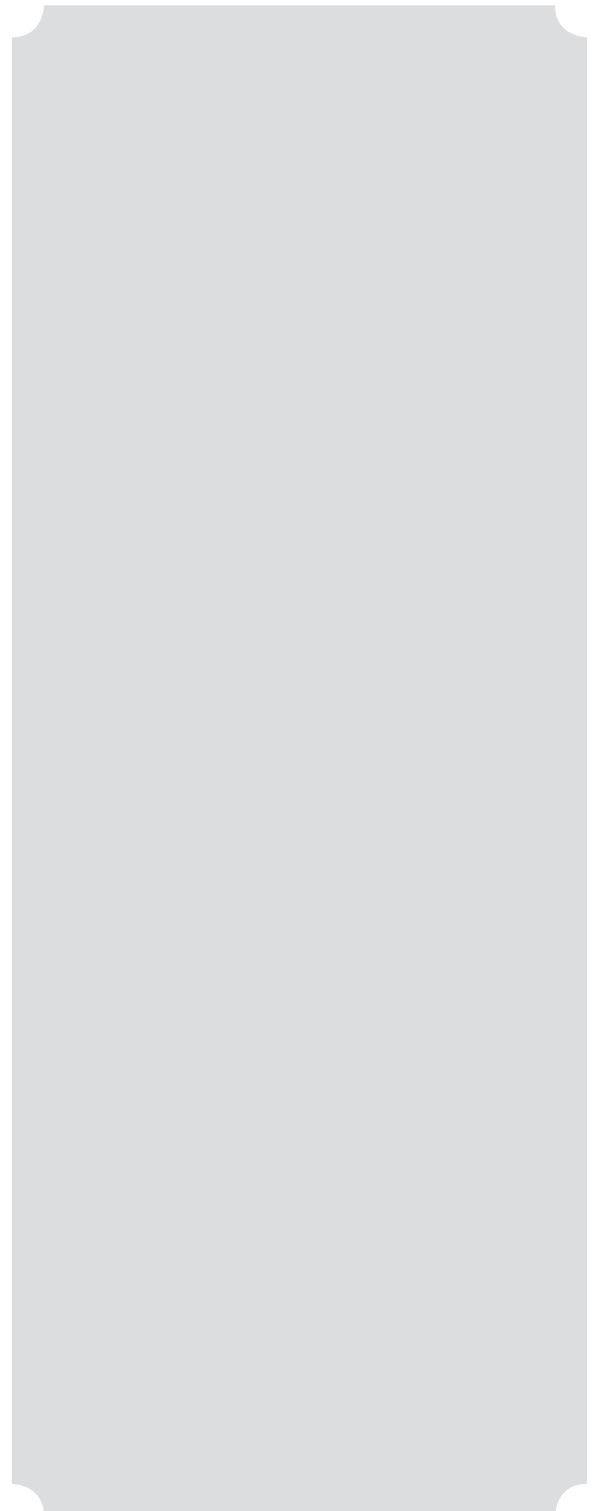
1. Faith is the evidence that I have
confidence in God's revelation.

2. That faith gains the approval of God.

B. A fundamental outlook of faith. (Heb 11:3)

1. God is outside the created realm of
things.

2. God is outside the course of ages.



C. Early evidences of faith

1. Abel - God's approval of the offering is the proof of faith.

D. Faith seeks God.

1. Without faith it is impossible to please God.

2. Faith comes to God with two convictions.

a) God is exactly as He is revealed.

b) God is knowable and therefore seeking Him is the highest aim.
