SESSION 7: SPREAD OF SIN

A. Results of Sin in Adam's experience.

Immediate consciousness of loss.

- 1) Guilt and fear enter the experience.
- 2) Afraid of God
- 3) Could not cure the difficulty

Relationship changes

- 1) Angry words from God.
- 2) Selfishness mars Adam and Eve's relationship.

Relationship with the environment.

- 1) Adam is no longer undisputed lord.
- 2) Adam is put out of the garden.

Death enters the experience.

- 1) <u>God is true and just</u> Death touches Adam's experience immediately.
- 2) <u>God is merciful</u> Physical death is delayed Adam has time to repent.

B. Rapid spread of the sin problem

- Adam eats the fruit
- Adam betrays his wife.
- Cain kills Abel
- Lamech kills, threatens, boasts and commands God.
- At Flood- Gen. 6:5 "every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- After the flood- Noah sins.

At Babel - Men refuse to follow God's directives.

C. Limiting factors on the spread of sin after the flood.

- 1. Death penalty allowed for murder.
- 2. Length of life is dramatically shortened.
- 3. People are separated into language groups.

D. Lessons on the Majesty and Glory of God.

- 1. God tells the truth.
- 2. God is able to deal with man's sin.
 - a. He may allow certain things.
 - b. Always able to deal with men when He is ready.
- 3. God is merciful- actively seeking to remedy man's condition
 - a. Man does not die immediately
 - b. Even the curse holds the element of promised deliverance.
 - c. God creates national identities so that He can create His own for redemption.
