### **SESSION 10:** JACOB

## A. Jacob and the Covenant.

- Covenant was first established with Abraham.
  - a. Renewed to Isaac
  - b. Renewed again to Jacob.
- 2. All of Jacob's descendants are part of the covenant blessing.
  - a. Because Jacob's name was changed to Israel, we know God's OT people as the nation of Israel

# B. Jacob's life becomes a picture of the nation of Israel's history.

### C. Key points in Jacob's story

- 1. Prophecy of Jacob's blessing before his birth. Gen. 25:22–26
  - a. Two nations were in the womb.
  - b. Abraham was to become a great nation.
  - c. Only one (the younger) could fulfill the covenant promise.
  - d. The Lord spoke to Rebekah but both would have known.
- 2. Brothers are completely different and the family became a family of favorites.
  - a. Isaac-Esau
  - b. Rebekah-Jacob
- 3. Jacob and the birthright. Gen. 25:27-34
  - a. Two separate blessings
    - i. **Birthright** Privileges that belonged to Esau as firstborn.

- ii. **Blessing** Privileges that belonged to the covenant
- b. Jacob takes advantage of Esau's short sightedness.
- 4. Stealing the blessing. Gen. 27:1-29
  - a. Jacob gets by deception what he would have gotten anyway.
  - b. Along with the blessing he gets hardship.
- 5. Bethel Gen. 28:10-22
  - a. God reveals Himself to Jacob
  - b. Renews the covenant to him. Jacob makes a vow.
    - i. Key is "if".
    - ii. Promises a tenth to God when he is back.
- 6. Jacob and Laban.
  - a. Laban is just like Jacob.
    - i. By the measure with which you measure it will be measured to You.
  - b. God did bless Jacob despite the deceptions of Laban.
  - c. Stick and goats episode pictures Jacob's confusion.
  - d. Jacob flees from Laban- God delivers.
- 7. Jacob wrestles with God at Penuel.

#### Gen.32: 24-32

- a. Wrestles and seems to succeed
- b. Finally realizes who he is dealing with
- c. Calls out in faith to the angel.
- d. Leaves crippled but in faith.
