SESSION 12: PREPARATION OF MOSES

A. Moses' life- General Overview

- 1. Moses is one of two characters who dominates the OT history.
- 2. Moses life divides into three roughly equal sections.
 - a. Birth- 40 in the Egyptian Court as a prince.
 - b. 40-80 in the wilderness as a shepherd.
 - c. 80-120 in the Sinai desert as the leader of God's people.

B. Moses' Early Life

- 1. Began in a home of godly parents who had faith. (Heb. 11)
 - a. God had a purpose for Moses.
 - b. God's purpose was worked out by the faith of Moses parents.
- 2. Moses' unique blessing.
 - a. Blessing of a life of privilege in the court of Egypt
 - b. Blessing of the covenant and a godly family
- 3. Moses' act of faith. Heb. 11:24-27. Acts 7:22-29
 - a. Moses made a choice.
 - Must have been based on a knowledge of the covenant with Abraham.
 - 1. Moses believed God
 - 2. Moses looked at life from an eternal perspective
 - Moses chose to identify with the people of God.

- Determined to use his position for their benefit.
- Great self renunciation A real act of faith.
 - 1. God did not support his efforts.
 - 2. God did not protect his privilege
 - 3. God did protect him.

C. Moses' Call to Action - the Burning Bush

- 1. God's Revelation
 - a. Begins with a revelation of God-"I am holy."
 - b. Proceeds to a revelation of God's heart- "I have seen."
 - c. Finishes with a revelation of God's plan- "I have come to deliver."
 - d. Moses is included in God's plan-"Go to Pharoah."
- 2. Moses' Response- I can't
 - a. Moses is still not a man of mature faith.
 - In Egypt Moses was caught up with what he was;
 - In the wilderness Moses became caught up with what he was not.
 - God's goal was to get
 Moses to a place where he was caught up with God.
- 3. As Moses obeys,
 - a. God will act
 - b. Moses will grow in faith
