SESSION 24: JOSHUA'S COMMISSION

A. General Introductory Information

- Joshua is the first book after the Law is finished.
- 2. Book still covers the foundational phase of the national period.
 - a. Exodus-Israel is freed
 - b. Law- Israel is organized
 - c. Conquest (Joshua) Israel is given the land.
- 3. Joshua is the key character to the book.
- 4. Possession is the key word.
 - a. Outline
 - i. Possession through Entrance 1-5
 - ii. Possession through Warfare 6-12
 - iii. Possession through Division 13-24
- 5. Key event-Crossing the Jordan River Ch. 3
- 6. Book takes about 15-20 years.
 - a. Begins immediately after the mourning for Moses.
 - b. Conquest lakes about 7 years.

B. Joshua's Commission and the principle of victory

- 1. Note- God's work does not stop because of the death of His leaders.
- 2. Principle of the conquest
 - a. Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given.

Joshua 1:3

- i. God determines the limits of the blessing, 1:4
- ii. God gives victory before the conflict. 1:3
- iii. Joshua must take what has been given by active faith.
- iv. No one can stop Joshua if he walks with God. 1:5
- 3. Joshua's part-Strong, Courageous Faith.
 - a. Be strong and courageous is repeated three times.
 - Because the attack will be against Joshua to get him to quit.
 - ii. Joshua must be strong by counting on God's promise.
 - b. Where is courageous faith necessary?
 - i. Strong to believe that there will be victory.
 - 1. Be strong and courageous for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. 1:6
 - Joshua must resist with strong, courageous faith the temptation to quit because the going gets hard.
 - a. The promise is victory in the end

not ease along the way.

- ii. Strong to believe the Word of God is the right way to go. 1:7-8
 - 1. This is the point to which the most time is given.
 - Maintain confidence by maintaining constant consideration of the word.
 - 3. Living by the Word takes courageous faith.
 - 4. Leading others to follow the Word takes courageous faith.
- iii. Strong to believe the Lord is with you continually.

1:9

- 1. God is not always manifestly with us.
- 2. Fear that He is no longer with and for us creates pressure to quit,
- 3. I have commanded-I will see it through.
