SESSION 25: JOSHUA - LESSONS FROM THE CONQUEST

A. Important facts about the conquest.

- 1. Total time about 7 years.
- 2. The conquest involves 3 primary campaigns
 - a. Central Canaan Jericho- Ai
 - b. The Southern Confederation.
 - c. The Northern Confederation
- 3. The conquest dealt with the main strongholds of opposition.
 - a. Completion of the conquest was left to the individual tribes after the division of the land.

B. Some key lessons from the conquest.

- 1. Man with the Drawn Sword (Lesson 1). Joshua 5:13-15
 - a. Joshua is contemplating the next move.
 - b. Lord appears to him in the form of a soldier.
 - c. Joshua "Are you for us or for our enemies?"
 - d. God's answer. "No"
 - i. I am not on anyone's side.
 - ii. I am the captain of the hosts of the Lord.
 - iii. Issue is whether or not Joshua is on the Lord's side.
- 2. Man with the Drawn Sword (Lesson 2)

- a. The Lord will reveal Himself to you exactly the way you need to do the will of God.
- b. The Lord is with him as the head of an angelic army.
- c. Pay attention to how God reveals Himself to you.

3. Lesson of Jericho - Joshua 6

- a. Jericho was one of 31 fortresses in Canaan.
- b. Basic approach to warfare was to retreat into the fortress and hope for frustration on the part of the attacker
 - To attack is very costly since the defender has the advantage.
 - ii. To lay siege is costly in time.Often up to a year toconquer a well preparedcity.
- c. How long will the conquest take?
- d. God is able to do the exceedingly abundant.
 - i. Walls falling down would be a great testimony to Israel of God's power.
 - ii. It would also be a trigger of great fear among the Canaanites. There would have to be another way.
 - This led to large coalitions which fought in the open field.

4. Lesson of Variety

a. God directed every victory Israel

experienced. (19)

- b. No two are alike.
 - i. Jericho- All God's work
 - ii. Ai (final victory) Mainly a natural military technique.
 - iii. Victory over the southern coalition.
 - God- the sun stood still
 - Israel- had to fight for 36 continuous hours.
- c. All were faith-acts of obedient trust
