II. Key Issues in Jeremiah's Commission

- A. Manner of the commission
 - 1. Jeremiah has no choice
 - a. Contrasted to Isaiah
 - b. Before you were born I knew you
 - c. I have appointed you
 - 2. Jeremiah's protest I am a youth
 - 3. God's reply
 - a. Where I send you, you will go
 - b. What I give you, you will speak
 - c. I will protect you
 - 4. God chose a very sensitive man for a very difficult ministry
 - 5. I have appointed you over the nations and over the kingdoms
 - a. Humorous since Jeremiah was given so little respect
 - b. Jeremiah's words came to pass
 - c. Jeremiah's works still give blessing
- B. Visions given at the commission
 - 1. Almond rod
 - a. Almond tree blossoms were a sign of spring

- b. Application: I will eventually fulfill all I am saying
 - (1) This is important since there are over 40 years between the beginning of Jeremiah's ministry and the fall of Jerusalem
- 2. Pot facing out of the north
 - a. Kettle of boiling olive oil which has tipped over spilling its contents
 - b. Boiling oil speaks of judgment
 - c. Coming from the north indicates the judgement is an army from the Tigris Euphrates area
 - (1) At this point in time Assyria would be in mind

III. Jeremiah's Initial Message

- A. I remember concerning you the devotions of your youth (2:2)
 - 1. Love of the early period of their relationship
 - 2. Because of this relationship departure is seen as adultery
- B. Judah's sin
 - 1. Unique among the nations no one changes false Gods
 - 2. Nature of the departure
 - a. Forsaken the fountain of living waters
 - b. Carve out cisterns
 - c. Despite the fact that the cisterns are unable to hold water Judah did not return to God
