 - 1. Return was difficult
 - 2. Life in Babylon was good
- E. When they returned, building the temple became the priority
 - 1. Every work of God has two sides
 - a. There is real work
 - b. There is real conflict
 - 2. Work started immediately
 - a. Altar was set up, and sacrifices begana good start
 - b. Men were hired, and the foundation was laid
 - 3. Attack to stop the work
 - a. Discouragement
 - (1) This is nothing compared to the first temple
 - (2) The work cannot be done
 - b. Fear
 - (1) Sometimes superficial threats and taunts
 - (2) Sometimes real actions
 - (a) Letter sent to the king
 - 4. Work stops
 - a. Wait for a better time
 - b. Get our own lives in order
 - 5. Haggai comes to speak 16 years later
 - a. Get back to work
 - b. Zerubabbel responds and the building resumed
