- A. Prophetic pattern
 - 1. Restoration to the land
 - 2. Renewal of the people
 - 3. Coming of the Messiah
- B. Essential features of the renewal
 - 1. Psalm of remembrance of the lovingkindness of the Lord
 - 2. Commitment to follow the Lord
 - a) Separation from marriages with non-Israelis
 - b) Commitment to keep the Sabbath
 - c) Contribution to the needs of the temple and the priesthood

II. Place of Malachi in History of the Remnant Period

- A. Placement is difficult
 - 1. No reference to Malachi in either Ezra or Nehemiah
 - 2. No reference to time in Malachi
 - 3. Late in OT history
 - a) Either before Ezra
 - b) Or after Nehemiah
 - 4. Because of the reference to anticipation of the Messiah, we will place it late

III. Conditions During Malachi's Ministry

- A. External worship seems to be going on
- B. Anticipation of the Messiah seems strong
- C. Zeal for the things of God has cooled
- D. The people are out of touch with their own condition
 - 1. Eight questions of surprise are asked in the book
 - 2. Zeal has cooled but no one seems aware of it
 - 3. The situation is similar to the condition pictured in the church of Laodicea (Revelations 3:15-19)
 - 4. Real problems
 - a) Questioning God's love (1:1-5)
 - b) Offering defective animals for sacrifice (1:6-14)
 - c) Foreign marriages (2:10-12)
 - d) Divorce (2:13-16)
 - e) Withholding the tithe (3:8-12)
 - f) Complaint about difficulties (3:13-15)

IV. Malachi's Answer

- A. Recognize your condition and danger
- B. Return to Me and I will return to you (3:7)
 - 1. Demands a change of heart
 - 2. Demands a change of conduct
- C. Remember the day of the Lord (4:2)
