II. THE CRUCIFIXION (PSALM 22:1-21)

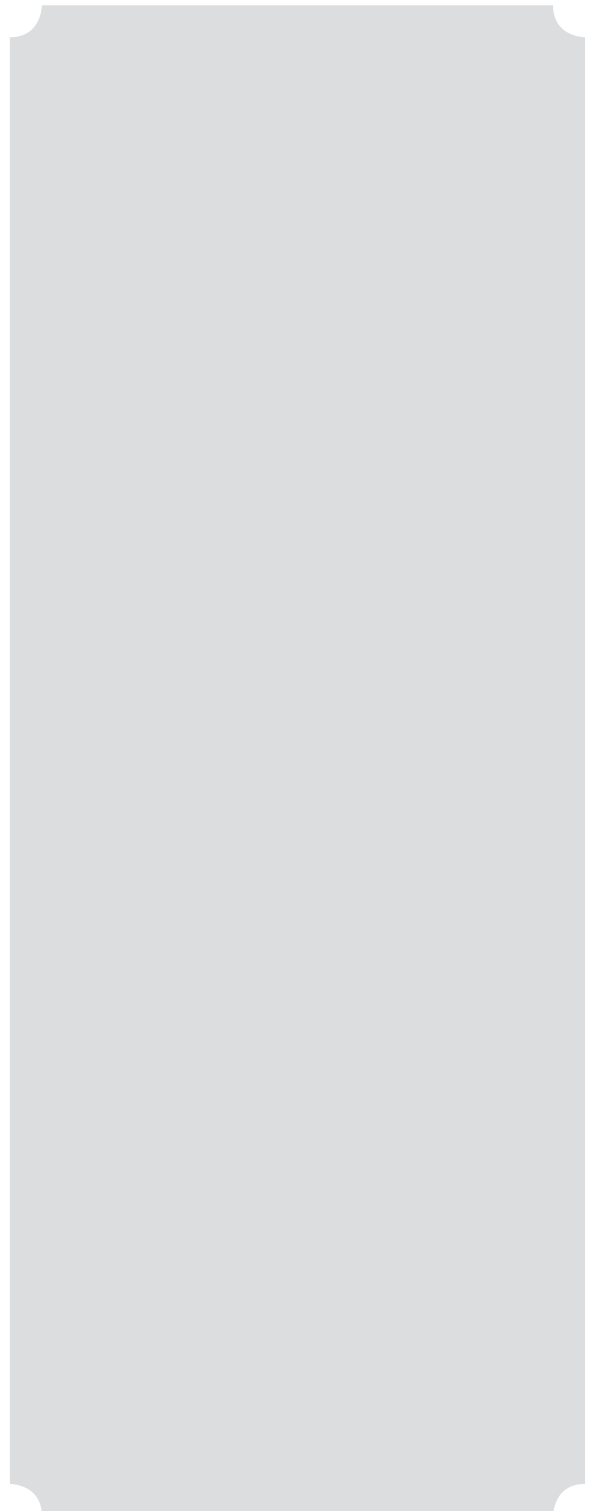
A. “My God, my God why have You forsaken me?” (Psalm 22:1)
