- A. The events of the cross were 7 weeks before.
- B. A promise was given that the Spirit would come.
- C. The ascension of the Lord was 10 days before.
- D. The disciples and others were gathered in a room.

II. THE STRUCTURE OF THE MESSAGE

A. An explanation of the event

1. The coming of the Spirit of God was promised by Joel.

B. An announcement of blessing to the world

- 1. "And it shall be that all who call upon the name of the Lord will be saved."
- 2. This is also according to the promise.

ACTS 1:8

...but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.

A C T S 2:17

- 1. You saw the character and power of the man Jesus.
- 2. You crucified Jesus through Roman hands
- 3. God raised Jesus up.
 - a. Psalm 16 This is what He said would happen.
 - b. We are witnesses.
 - c. This is the center of the Gospel message.
- 4. God has now exalted Jesus according to the promise of Psalm 110.

D. The application of the message

- 1. Know for certain.
 - a. Because of His promise
 - b. Because of the testimony of His life
 - c. Because of the testimony that He was raised from the dead
- 2. God has made Him both...
 - a. Lord One you must call upon
 - b. Christ His anointed One

A C T S 1:27
