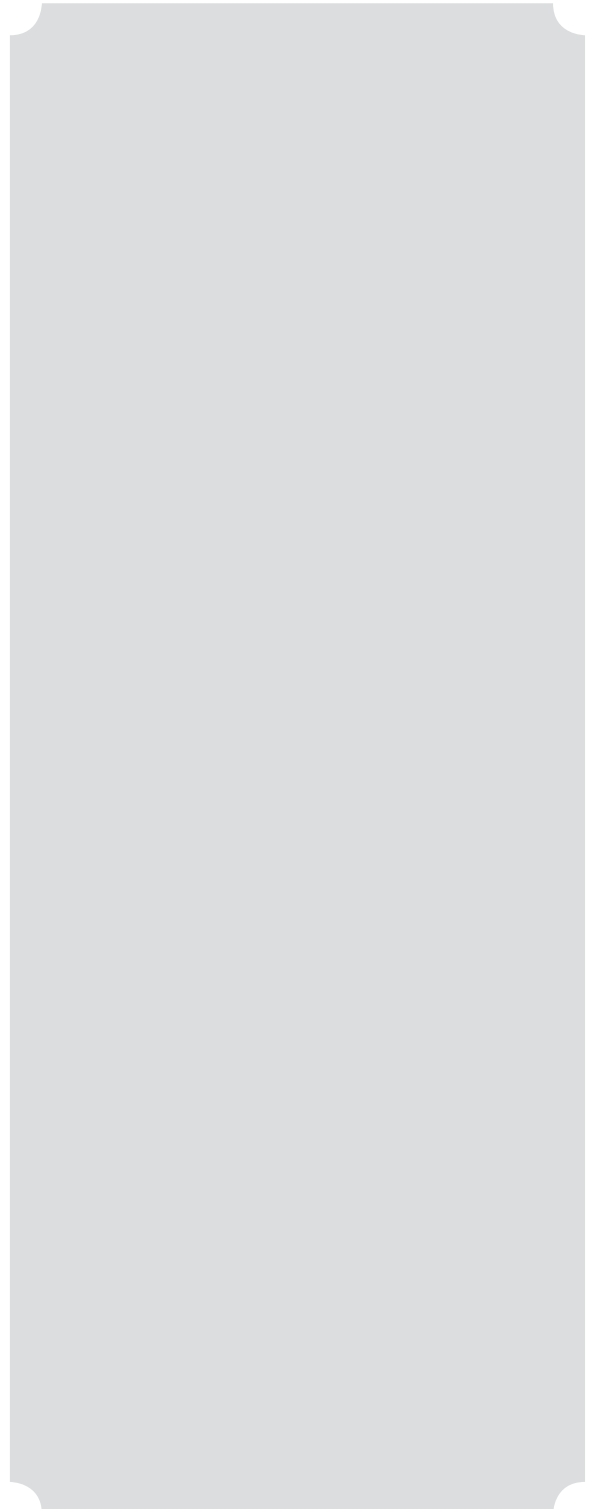
1. Not by type

II. TWO GREAT STATEMENTS TO THE MESSIAH

A. Sit at My right hand until I make your enemies your footstool.

1. David addresses the subject of the Psalm as his “Lord”.
2. The Lord is already on the throne, but awaiting the full defeat of His enemies.



3. The next step will be decisive.

a. Enemies will be defeated.

b. Supporters will give themselves
to him wholeheartedly.

**B. You are a priest forever according to the
order of Melchizedek.**

1. Only one priest is ever mentioned in this
“order”.

2. Melchizedek is associated with
Jerusalem.

a. King of peace - King of Salem

b. Name means “King of
Righteousness”.

3. The one who is awaiting his enemy’s
defeat is also a priest.
