 - A. Sit at My right hand until I make your enemies your footstool.
 - 1. David addresses the subject of the Psalm as his "Lord".
 - 2. The Lord is already on the throne, but awaiting the full defeat of His enemies.

- 3. The next step will be decisive.
 - a. Enemies will be defeated.
 - b. Supporters will give themselves to him wholeheartedly.
 - (1) A freewill offering
- B. You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.
 - 1. Only one priest is ever mentioned in this "order".
 - 2. Melchizedek is associated with Jerusalem.
 - a. King of peace King of Salem
 - b. Name means "King of Righteousness".
 - 3. The one who is awaiting his enemy's defeat is also a priest.
