- I. Because of the Work of the Spirit of God in the New Birth, a Christian can be Described as a Person "In Christ"
 - A. This is the work of the Spirit
 - B. Creates a spiritual union with Christ

II. How Can We Understand That Union?

- James Montgomery Boice in <u>Foundations of the Christian</u>
 <u>Faith</u> points out four biblical illustrations
- A. Picture of the union of a husband and wife- Ephesians 5:32
 - 1. Emphasis on a loving relationship
 - 2. Also involves a legal commitment
 - 3. Creates a working relationship
- B. Picture of the union of the head and the body Ephesians 1:22-23
 - 1. Emphasis on the authority of Christ over His own
 - 2. Further emphasis on the growing nature of the relationship
 - Points out that the union with Christ is not a private experience
 - 4. Again there is the creation of a working relationship

C. Picture of the union of the vine and a branch - John 15:1-7	
1. Emphasis on a shared life	
2. The goal of the flow of life is to produce fruit	
3. Emphasis on God's work to prune the vine to produce fruit	
D. Picture of the spiritual temple - Ephesians 2:20-22	
1. Emphasis on the permanence of the relationship	
Similar to Jesus' call to build your life upon the rock	
2. Emphasis is again on service	
a) Purpose of the temple is to enable people to come close to God
