## I. Faith Is Important to the Lord on Earth

- A. Jesus commended faith
  - 1. Centurion Matthew 8:10-12
  - 2. Syrophoenician Women *Matthew 15:28*
- B. Jesus reproved unbelief
  - 1. Chastens the crowd in the Sermon on the Mount
    - *Matthew 6:30*
  - 2. Disciples in the storm
    - *Matthew 8:26*
  - 3. Disciples who had forgotten bread
    - *Matthew 16:8*
- C. Without faith it is impossible to please God
  - Hebrews 11:6

## II. What Does It Mean to Have Faith in the Christian Life?

- A. Therefore, as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith...
  - Colossians 2:6-7
  - 1. How did you receive?
    - a. You recognized a need
    - You realized that you could not answer that need
    - c. You heard of the provision of God in Christ
    - d. You came and trusted Him to meet the need

- 2. How do we continue?
  - a. We recognize a need
  - b. We realize that we cannot meet that need
  - c. We learn of God's provision for our need in Christ
  - d. We trust Him to fulfill His promise and meet the need

## III. How Did This Work Out for Paul?

- Philippians 4:10-13
- A. Paul is in prison
  - 1. He cannot change his circumstances
  - 2. Paul does not complain
- B. Two outlooks necessary for contentment
  - 1. God was in control of His circumstances
  - 2. God has supplied everything necessary for those circumstances
    - a. I can do all things through Him (Christ) who strengthens me. Philippians 4:13
- C. Paul had come to this bold position of faith through a learning process
  - 1. Learning implies that there is a teacher
  - 2. Learning implies that there was opportunity to follow the teacher's instructions
  - 3. Learning implies that Paul had allowed the training to do its work
