- A. Typical passages
 - 1. Isaiah 5
 - 2. Jeremiah 2:21
 - 3. Ezekiel 15
- B. Common features of the passages
 - 1. Always speak of Israel
 - 2. Always speak of failure
 - 3. Always carry the threat of judgment

II. I Am the True Vine – Abide in MeJohn 15:1-8

- A. The reason the vine exists is to bear fruit
 - 1. Fruit comes through discipleship
- B. Method of bearing fruit for the branch is to abide remain in contact
 - 1. The church has a calling with an enabling
 - 2. Apart from this relationship the disciples are nothing
- C. Benefit of abiding in Christ
 - 1. Enables a flow of life resulting in fruitfulness
 - 2. Creates the potential of powerful praying

III. I Have Loved You – Abide in My LoveJohn 15:9-16

- A. The disciples have been loved by the Lord in the same way He is loved by His Father
- B. All of the Christian life grows out of that love
 - 1. Remain there
 - 2. Live in this realization
- C. What is the outworking of abiding in the love of Christ?
 - 1. The disciples keep the Lord's commandments
 - 2. The disciples love each other
- D. In His love the Lord shares with His disciples what He is doing
- E. The benefit of abiding in the love of Christ
 - 1. Security I have chosen you
 - 2. Fruitfulness bearing the fruit that remains
 - 3. Power in praying that whatever you ask
