

Cellphone policy

During the Totally His Youth Conference, we desire to create an environment where campers can focus on getting to know the Lord and cultivate relationships with others. We have established a cellphone policy to help everyone be fully engaged in the activities and to build meaningful relationships with others.

Cellphone collection

At check-in, campers will be asked to turn off their cellphones and other electronic devices (including smart watches, Ipads and/or other tablets.) and submit them to the camp staff. The phones and electronic devices will be securely stored. The cellphones, but not electronic devices, may be used during camp but only in the times specified below.

Cellphone permitted area

During the camp, in the afternoons after sports, campers may go to the main office and “check-out” their cellphones but not their other electronic devices. Cellphones should only be used for calls or texts. Cellphones should not be used for any other reason including watching videos or playing games. Cellphones should only be used in the office building. Before they leave the office building, campers must return their cellphone. If a cellphone is used for any reason other than calls or texts, that cellphone will not be allowed to be used again until the end of the camp.

Prohibited possession

Campers are prohibited from possessing cellphones or any other electronic devices during the camp. If a camper is found with a cellphone or other electronic device, it will be immediately confiscated by the staff and held until the end of the camp.

Emergency situations

If parents need to get in contact with their camper due to an emergency, they can contact the school’s main office at 864-678-4900 or 864-678-4914.

Cellphone return

Campers should come to the main office on Saturday after lunch to retrieve their cellphones. Each camper must retrieve their cellphone and/or electronic device. Cellphones and/or electronic devices will not be given to anyone other than the owner.
